



Purdue Global Law School Scholarship

Purdue Global Law School has established a scholarship for new students enrolling in Purdue Global Law School's Juris Doctor and Executive Juris Doctor programs.

Award

The Purdue Global Law School Scholarship is equal to a 20% tuition reduction per term off the standard **per-credit** tuition rate of \$575 (Juris Doctor) or \$545 (Executive Juris Doctor).

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a first-time enrollee in the Juris Doctor or Executive Juris Doctor degree program at Purdue Global Law School.
- For the Juris Doctor degree program, must meet all Purdue Global Law School admissions requirements, including a bachelor's degree from a regionally or nationally accredited institution recognized by the U.S. Department of Education and recognized by the Committee of Bar Examiners of the State Bar of California.
- For the Executive Juris Doctor degree program, must meet all Purdue Global Law School admissions requirements, including a bachelor's degree from a regionally or nationally accredited institution recognized by the U.S. Department of Education.
- Must be fully accepted into the program.
- Must provide an officially verified LSAT score of 154 or above or achieve a score of 34 or above on the Purdue Global Law School Admissions Exam.

Other Terms and Conditions

- An applicant cannot retake the Purdue Global Law School Admissions Exam in order to qualify for the Purdue Global Law School Scholarship once the eligibility score for their program of interest has been met.
- Selection of the award recipients is made by Purdue Global Law School. All applicants agree to accept the decision of Purdue Global Law School as final.
- An official transcript from the applicant's bachelor's degree must be provided prior to enrollment. If the transcript is not provided prior to enrollment, the student will not be eligible for the Purdue Global Law School Scholarship and will be responsible for full tuition costs.
- If the student meets all eligibility to qualify, the Scholarship award will be applied at the beginning of each term for as long as the student qualifies.

- Juris Doctor scholarship students who change to the Executive Juris Doctor program may maintain scholarship eligibility if they are in compliance with the Executive Juris Doctor requirements for continued eligibility.
- The Scholarship cannot be used in conjunction with any other Purdue Global Law School tuition reductions (including active-duty and veterans military tuition rates), grants, vouchers, or other scholarships. Employees of Kaplan, Inc., and its subsidiaries, and their spouses or children are not eligible.

Continued Eligibility:

- To remain eligible for a scholarship, students must maintain at least a 3.0 CGPA after their first academic year (three terms in an academic year) for the duration of their program at Purdue Global Law School. If the student was awarded the Scholarship and does not maintain the required CGPA, he or she will not be eligible to receive the Scholarship. This may result in an out-of-pocket payment.
- Must remain in good financial standing with Purdue Global.
- All required documents must be on file at Purdue Global for the Scholarship to be awarded.

Notes:

1. Scholarship disbursement eligibility cannot be regained by the student once it is lost.
2. Purdue Global Law School reserves the right to amend scholarship policies or awards, or discontinue granting scholarships to additional students at any time.
