Purdue Global Law School Merit Scholarship Award

The Merit Scholarship Award is designed to acknowledge the academic achievements of the JD and EJD students who have achieved the highest CGPA in their respective programs in their penultimate term. The \$500 Scholarship will be applied in the form of a tuition credit toward the students' final enrolled term. Scholarships are awarded once per term for a total of six per year (two students per term, three terms per year).

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Must have achieved the highest CGPA in the EJD or JD program as verified by the Office
 of the Dean as of their penultimate term.
- Must have been enrolled in at least 5 credits in each term in the prior academic year.

ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Awardees must enroll in and complete the final term of their academic program.
- In the event of a tie, all recipients with the highest CGPA will be awarded the Scholarship.
- Selection of recipients is made by Purdue Global Law School. All applicants agree to accept the decision of Purdue Global Law as final.

OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- A student can only receive the Scholarship once during their lifetime enrollment at Purdue Global Law School.
- Awards are not transferable.
- There is no direct cash benefit provided. The Scholarship will be provided as a credit on recipients' Purdue Global Law School student ledger.
